

## 2010 SCHOLARSHIP GRANT ANNOUNCEMENT

Science progresses anywhere true exchange is possible. Exchange of experience, of know-how, of procedures, of solutions, of results. This is the reason why Fondazione Veronesi promotes a culture of science without boundaries, favouring professional training of worthy scholars from Italy and other countries around the world.

### AMOUNT AND DURATION

The Fondazione grants **10 €25,000 scholarships** (annual value of each scholarship), renewable for a further two years, aimed at promoting the training of young scientists in clinical research and transfer to top level structures in Italy and abroad.

### RECIPIENTS

The scholarships are addressed to candidates with a degree in Medicine and similar degrees, not over 35 years of age with post-degree clinical and/or research experience (specialty, doctorate or equivalent experience). Given the program's transfer features, a preference will be given to degrees in Medicine.

Preference will also be given to studies in the general area of Clinical Oncology (specifically in the Breast and Thoracic Surgery areas) and in the general sector of Cardiology (heart and vascular surgery).

Specifically, the scholarships granted by Fondazione are aimed at:

- Foreign doctors and researchers

In order to favour the development of science in emerging countries, preference will be granted to candidates from Argentina, Brazil, Jordan, Iraq, Lebanon and Mexico.

The chosen candidates will carry out the period of study and work at the Istituto Europeo di Oncologia di Milano, and will be inserted in specialist teams according to their expertise coordinated by high level referents.

- Italian doctors and researchers

The chosen candidates will carry out a period of study and work at international top level centres: a concrete opportunity for professional growth, in depth study and confrontation.
